Søren Pind was appointed minister for the Ministry of Higher Education and Science 28 November 2016.

Mr. Pind is a Danish lawyer and politician, a member of the center-right party Venstre. He served as Danish Minister of Justice from 2015 to 2016. He served as councillor in the Copenhagen City Council from 1994 to 2005,[1] and has taught at the University of Copenhagen.
